Renowned historian Nelson Johnson will discuss the origins of New Jersey's 1947 Constitution under which lawyers and judges still operate today. That living Constitution emerged from fierce ethnic wars personified by Jersey City Mayor Frank "I am the Law" Hague and power broker-lawyer Arthur Vanderbilt. This ethnic strife unfolded over several decades in the first half of the 20th Century and yielded a reformed court system which seeks equal justice for all. Retired Judge Johnson's book, *Battleground New Jersey* was published by Rutgers University Press in 2014. Judge Johnson's latest book, coming out in 2021, will examine Clarence Darrow's harrowing experiences in California, a key turning point in Darrow's career.
