Proven historian Nelson Johnson's 2021 book, *Darrow's Nightmare*, looks back at the most harrowing period in the life of America's most renowned trial lawyer, Clarence Darrow. Called to California by the labor movement to represent two brothers charged with the murderous bombing of the Los Angeles Times building, Darrow found himself indicted twice for jury tampering. Judge Johnson will discuss his book, and together with Judge Hely, will examine the ethics of advocacy and trial technique.
